JACK ADAMS, CFSP, MBIE has over 50 years of funeral experience. Jack served as a Dodge sales representative in Illinois since 1989, retiring in 2018, and he still remains active as a part-time Embalming Lab Instructor at Worsham College of Mortuary Science.

Personalized Embalming It is hoped all embalmers practice personalized embalming but in truth, we know there are a lot of cookie-cutter embalmings performed on a daily basis. You ask, what is personalized embalming? It is a process whereby the embalmer takes the entire decedent into consideration, that includes looking at a photo or multiple photos, noting their expression or smile, distinct features and creating an image and memory the family will recognize and appreciate. Through this procedure, the funeral service practitioner employs all his or her skills to present the decedent in a way to allow the family have closure and peace.

Proactive vs Reactive Embalming Without a doubt, proactive embalming is always easier than reactive embalming. Part of your initial embalming analysis should proactively predict some of the challenges the decedent presents you with, and you should take the appropriate steps to address these prior to embalming. That being said, we will never be 100% correct in our analysis and should be prepared to react and have a strategy ready to correct problems as they arise or occur post-embalming. This program will show you skills you can add to your "tool kit" to deal with situations as they arise.



DOMINIC J. ASTORINO, CFSP has over 20 years of experience as a funeral director and embalmer since he began his career in 2003. He has a Bachelor of Science degree in Mortuary Science from Wayne State and will be completing his Masters degree in Forensic Medicine at the University of Florida College of Medicine in 2023. He is an adjunct professor at both Wayne State and Worsham College of Mortuary Science and has been presenting to professional groups and associations since 2018.

What To Use and When To Use It Dodge has been asked repeatedly about the differences between like-named products such as Basic Dryene and Penetrating Dryene and their use. Jaundice With Advanced Decomposition Embalming This presentation covers embalming of a severely jaundiced body in the presence of advanced decomposition and mummification. Lincoln will cover pre-embalming steps to be taken along with recommended chemical mixtures, as well as a step-by-step process to assure a properly embalmed body through arterial injection, cavity injection and topical preservation.

Post-Embalming Treatment of an Extremely Jaundiced Body with DehydrationThis presentation will cover ways to stabilize and preserve tissues that were not sufficiently preserved during normal arterial embalming, and to better prepare the deceased for dressing and cosmetizing. Some of the topics to be covered include:

- Addressing dehydration/mummification
- Skin slip
- Extreme icterus (jaundice)
- Collapsed eyes
- Treatment of weeping fluid, edema, bruising
- Post-embalming steps to facilitate re-hydration of tissues



TOM SHERMAN has 25 years experience working in the funeral industry. He has been a licensed funeral director and embalmer since 2005 and earned a diploma in Mortuary Science from the Commonwealth Institute of Funeral Service Houston in 2013. Tom has been the Dodge Sales Representative for the Central and West Texas area since 2013 and is a contributor of articles for the *Dodge Magazine* on difficult embalming issues.

We Want The Casket To Stay Open: Restoration of Emaciated Remains
In this presentation participants will have an opportunity to focus on emaciated remains which often present challenges for embalmers, even the most skilled embalmers. However, by becoming familiar with different techniques for casketing emaciated bodies, as well as other embalming techniques, you will soon learn that it is possible to keep the casket open for visitation.
